AOP Côtes de Provence 2017 Rosé

A Wine faithful to its Terroir

Both elegant and assertive, this wine is unquestionably different and never leaves anyone indifferent

Terroir

A mixture of clay and sand overlaying crystalline rock, gneiss, and granite with various degrees of degradation

Tasting Notes

Beautiful lychee-pink color with peach highlights. Complex intensity on the nose with aromas of exotic fruits, hints of marshmallow and blackcurrant buds. The palate is generous and expresses mineral overtones. It will enchant you even more as it opens. A charming wine with minerality and a long aftertaste.

Originality

Paul SIGNAC was the first painter to live in Saint-Tropez in the late 19th century. He was one of the leaders of the neo-impressionist movement. The Cuvée Paul Signac, which comes in rosé, white, and red, pays homage to the outstandingly beautiful vineyards surrounding Saint-Tropez

Grape Varieties

Grenache 35%, Cinsault 25%, Mourvèdre 20%, Carignan 20%

Winemaking

The wine is made with a studied blend of grapes from different plots. The fruit is picked only when it reaches just the right degree of ripeness in late August. The grapes are cooled down to a temperature of 5-8°C as soon as they arrive at the cellar. Once the grapes are gently pressed, the must is protected by low temperatures and a blanket of nitrogen gas. After the must has been racked, temperature-controlled alcoholic fermentation takes place for 3-4 weeks on the lees with regular stirring

Serving suggestion – Wine & food matches – Ageing potential

Best enjoyed chilled (10-12°C) with smoked fish, white meats, soft-ripened cheeses, etc.
